

# History of Khmelnytsky Polytechnic College



The history of the creation of Khmelnytsky electromechanical college falls on the first half of the 60's of the last century.



In 1957, the construction of a transformer substation plant (today - Ukrelectrequarter), which was fully completed in 1965. Then 3,000 workers worked on it, which produced electrical equipment almost 30 million rubles per year and the need for skilled frames grew.

That is why in 1965 the decision of the Podolsk soviet economy (Vinnytsia) to establish the Khmelnytsky Electromechanical Technical School (HEMT) appeared. The newly established educational institution is located in the premises of the former school № 9 (Industrialna Street), now Chornovola Street.



An important role in the creation and construction of the technical school was played by the director of the plant Mykola Petrash, who was constantly interested in the problems of the technical school and provided great practical assistance. In a short time, with the help of the basic enterprise HZTP, 12 offices and laboratories were created and equipped.





The first employee hired was the first director of the then Khmelnytsky Electromechanical College - Altukhov Ivan Egorovich. And this record dates back to August 26, 1965. On the same - the first page - under number 20 there is a record of hiring Shamarina Olga Yuriyivna. Today we all know her by the name of Osipov. At number 19 in the "Book of labor books" we see a record of the hiring of the first librarian of the college - Gusak Stepanida Iosifovna. By the way, her daughter, Larysa Vasylivna Zakhvatova, also dedicated her life to college, and has been teaching physics to our students for more than 30 years.



Altukhov was succeeded by Filimon Andriyovych Hryhoruk, who headed the HEMT team from 1971 to 1974. Under his leadership, the construction of a new building was completed, 24 offices and laboratories were equipped, and in 1972. opened a new specialty: "Technician-technologist for the operation of CNC machines.



In the period 1974-1979 the technical school was headed by Vasyl Ludvihovych Zbrytsky. He paid great attention to the development of technical, scientific and artistic creativity. The material base of the technical school has been strengthened, mechanical and metal workshops have been equipped.



In 1979-1984, Gennadiy Klyuyev was appointed as director. During this period, a standard work was raised to a qualitatively new level and the educational and methodological complex was created on all subjects.



From 1984 to 2014, our team was headed by Mykola Dmytrovych Bodaretsky - Honored Worker of Education of Ukraine, academician, excellent education, wise leader, a good decent man.

Thanks to his initiative, energy and perseverance, our institution occupies one of the first places in Podillya. The material and technical base is enriched, new specialties are opened: "Maintenance of computer and intellectual systems and networks", "Management in the production sphere", "Programming for electronic computers and automated systems", "Economics of the enterprise".





Specialists in seven specialties are trained, but in addition to the main specialty, students receive a certificate of computer operator, small business accountant, category B driver. Ten times the college was awarded prizes of the Ministry of Defense of the Soviet Union for quality training and military-patriotic education of youth. He held a college and prizes at exhibitions of technical creativity of the Ministry of Electrical Industry of the USSR. For the labor victories of student youth in socially useful work, the college was awarded the Red Flag of the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Special Education of the USSR and Ukrprofrada. In 1988, a correspondence department was established on the basis of the evening department.

In February 1991, thanks to the initiative and persistence of Bodaretsky, the technical school was one of the first institutions in Ukraine to receive the status of a college.

Unfortunately, on April 29, 2016, the life of Mykola Dmytrovych Bodaretsky ended.





In 2014, a candidate was elected to the position of director, and now - Doctor of Economics, Associate Professor Vadym Vladimirovich Ovcharuk. Due to his foresight and perseverance, on March 23, 2015 Khmelnytsky Polytechnic College was merged with the National University "Lviv Polytechnic". This gave a new powerful impetus to the development of the school. We increase the number of students every year. In 2018, for the first time in the history of the educational institution, an additional winter recruitment of graduates of vocational education institutions was carried out.



In May 2020, Khmelnytsky Polytechnic was the first and at that time the only one in Ukraine to install and set up a solar station on its own. 60 solar panels with a total capacity of 22.5 kWh were installed on the roof of the school, which generate about 3,000 kWh. electricity per month.







Khmelnitsky Polytechnics are real patriots. Having held flash mobs "Trident of embroideries", we twice, in 2017 and 2018, set records in Ukraine and were entered in the Book of Records of Ukraine.



The good glory of our educational institution has contributed to the fact that the Khmelnytsky Polytechnic College is the only educational institutions of this level, honored in September 2020 to meet a very major delegation in the President, Minister of Education, Governors, Deputies and Holders of the region.







Also Khmelnytsky Polytechnic College of Lviv Polytechnic is a recognized leader in the educational market of Ukraine. Irrefutable confirmation of this is the award of the National Rating of Quality of Goods and Services "STAR OF QUALITY" received in October 2020 addressed to managers and all specialists of enterprises, companies, institutions, which with their fruitful work and professionalism have made a significant contribution to Ukraine's development.
